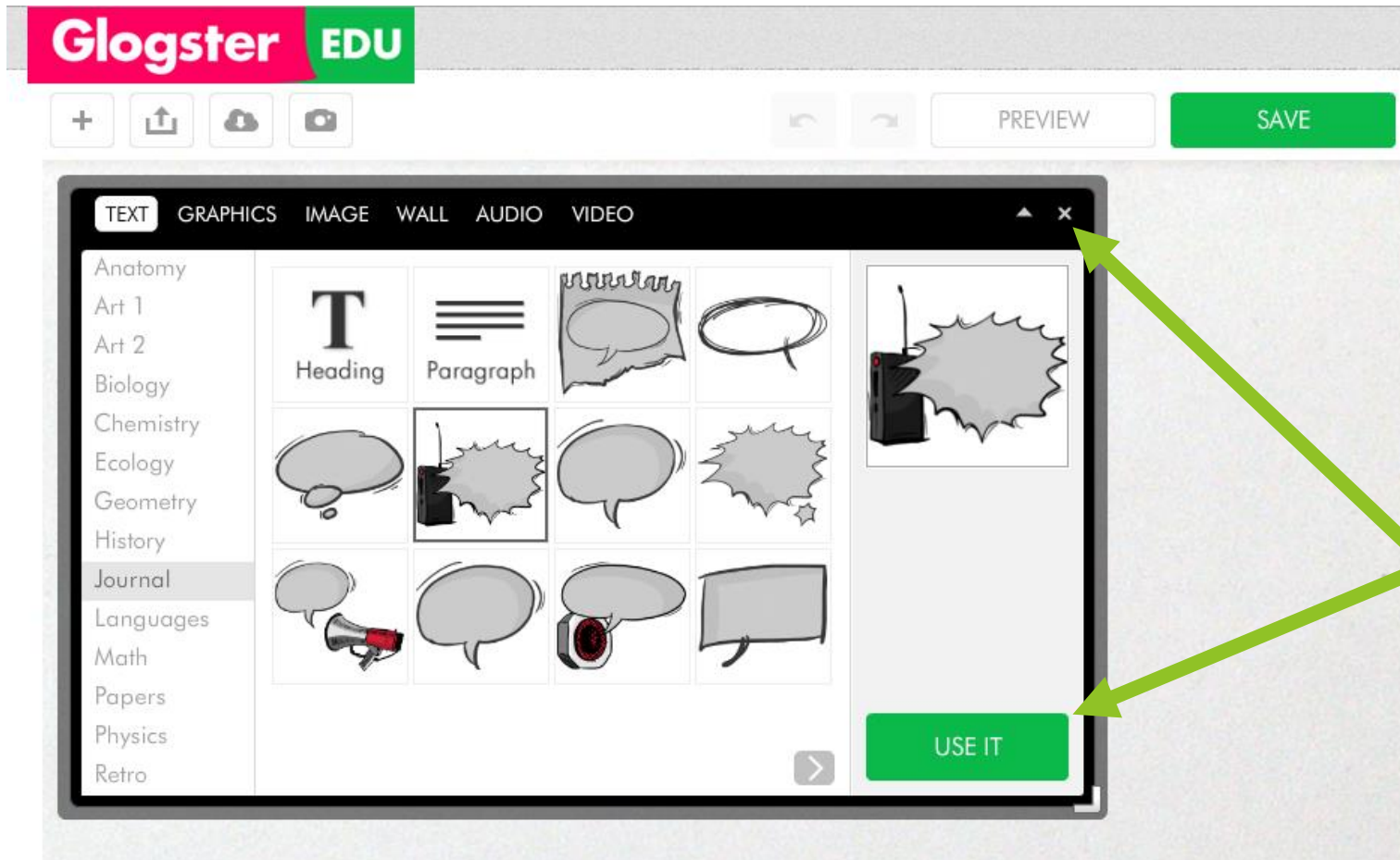

# Creating Glogs- Feature: Text



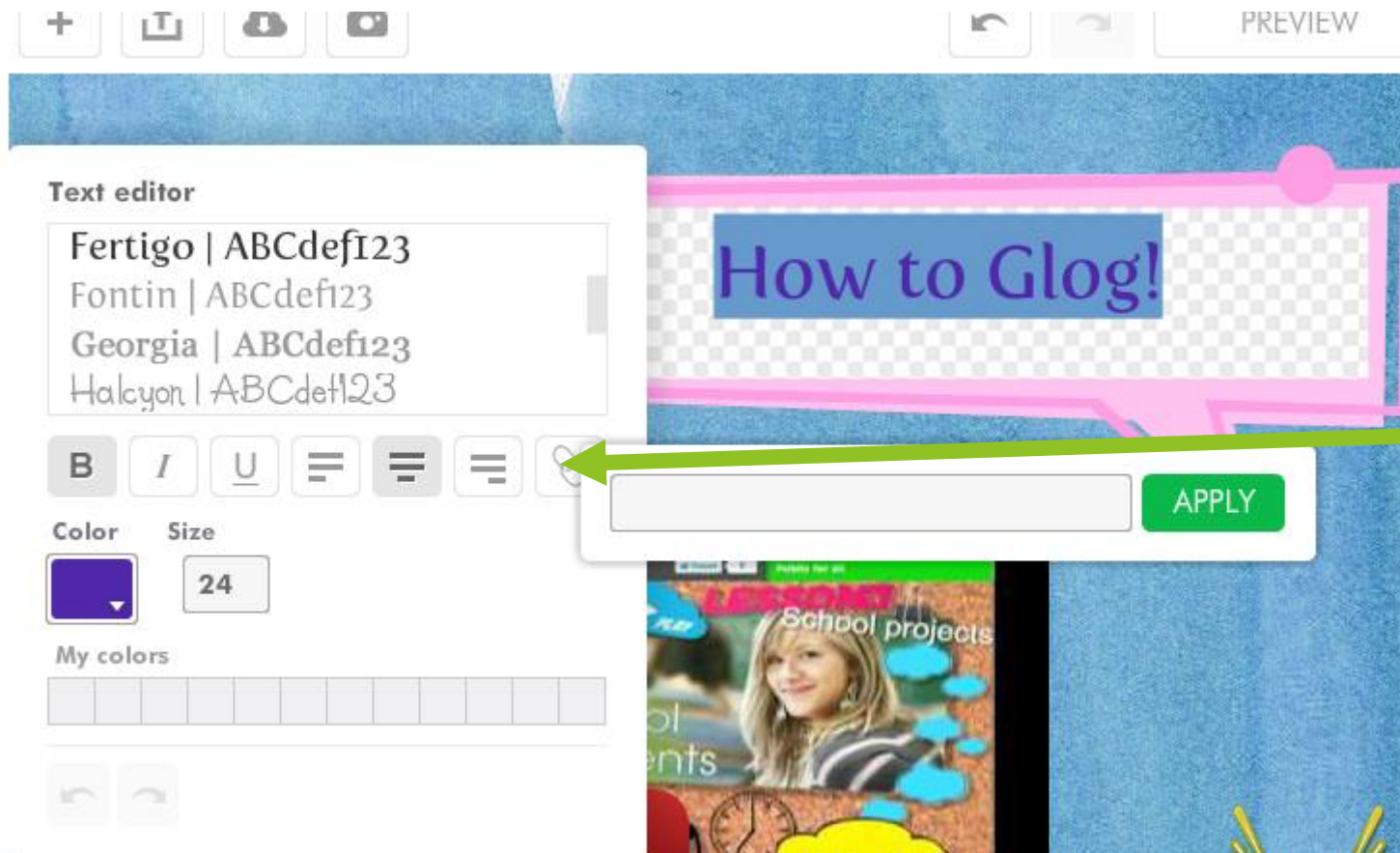
1. Helpful Hint! To delete an unwanted item, click on the item and hit delete on the keyboard.
2. There are many Texts to chose from. Find one that fits your style and Click Use It.
3. You may Select multiple text options from here. When you are set, click the X in the top right hand corner.

# Creating Glogs- Feature: Text




1. Helpful Hints! Don't forget to Save! You can also move and change the size of the text box by drag and drop methods.
2. There are many font styles to chose from. Find one that fits your style and Click Use It.
3. You can also change the color of text and alignment.

# Creating Glogs- Feature: Adding Links to Text



1. Helpful Hints! Remember the golden rule! Dark background- use light text. Light Background use dark text!
2. To add a link to a word, or group of words, click the "Chain link" button and paste the URL into the box. Click Apply.

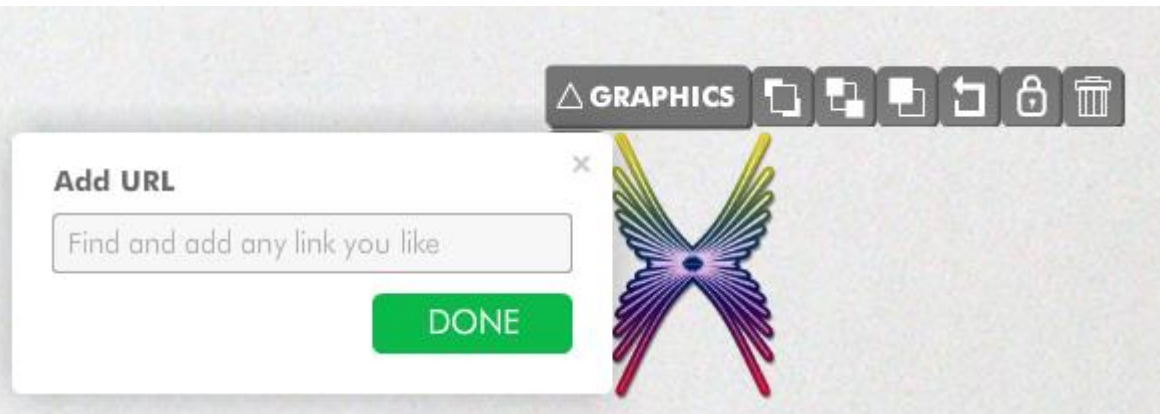

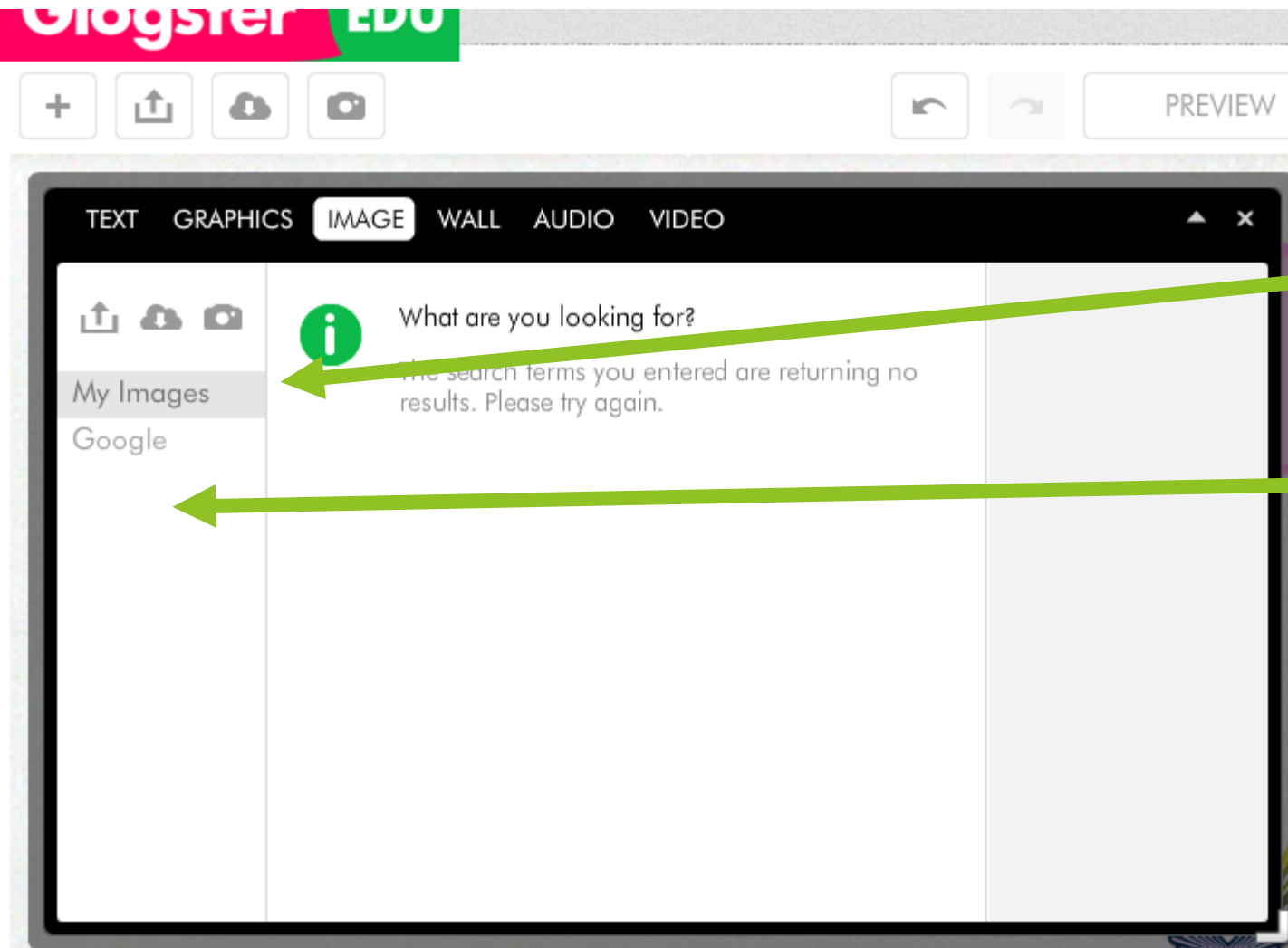
1. Helpful Hints! Although Glogster will Save automatically, you should Save the Glog as you go- just to be safe!

# Creating Glogs- Feature: Graphics



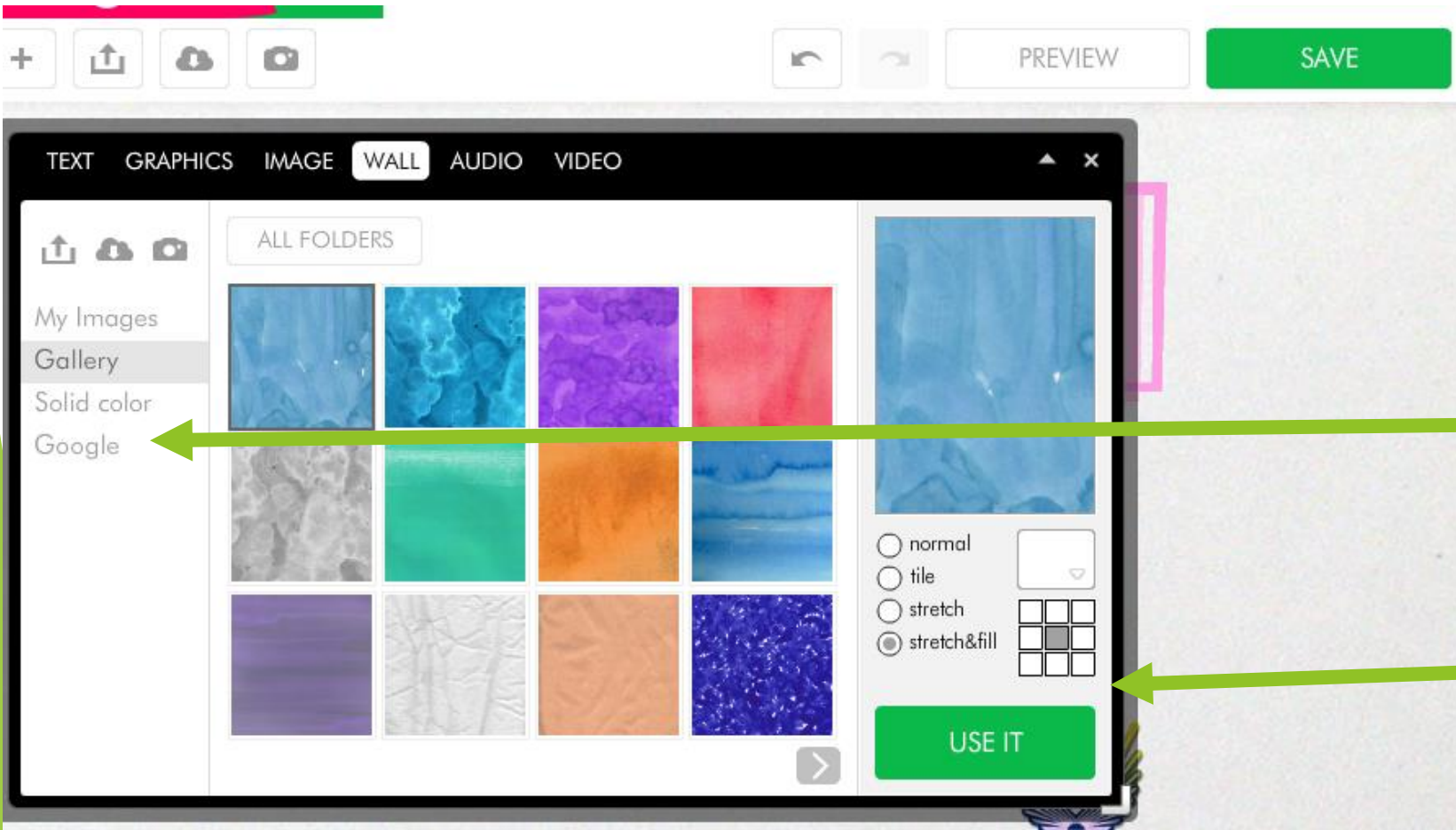
1. Helpful Hint! You can LOCK DOWN all items once in place so they do not accidentally move.

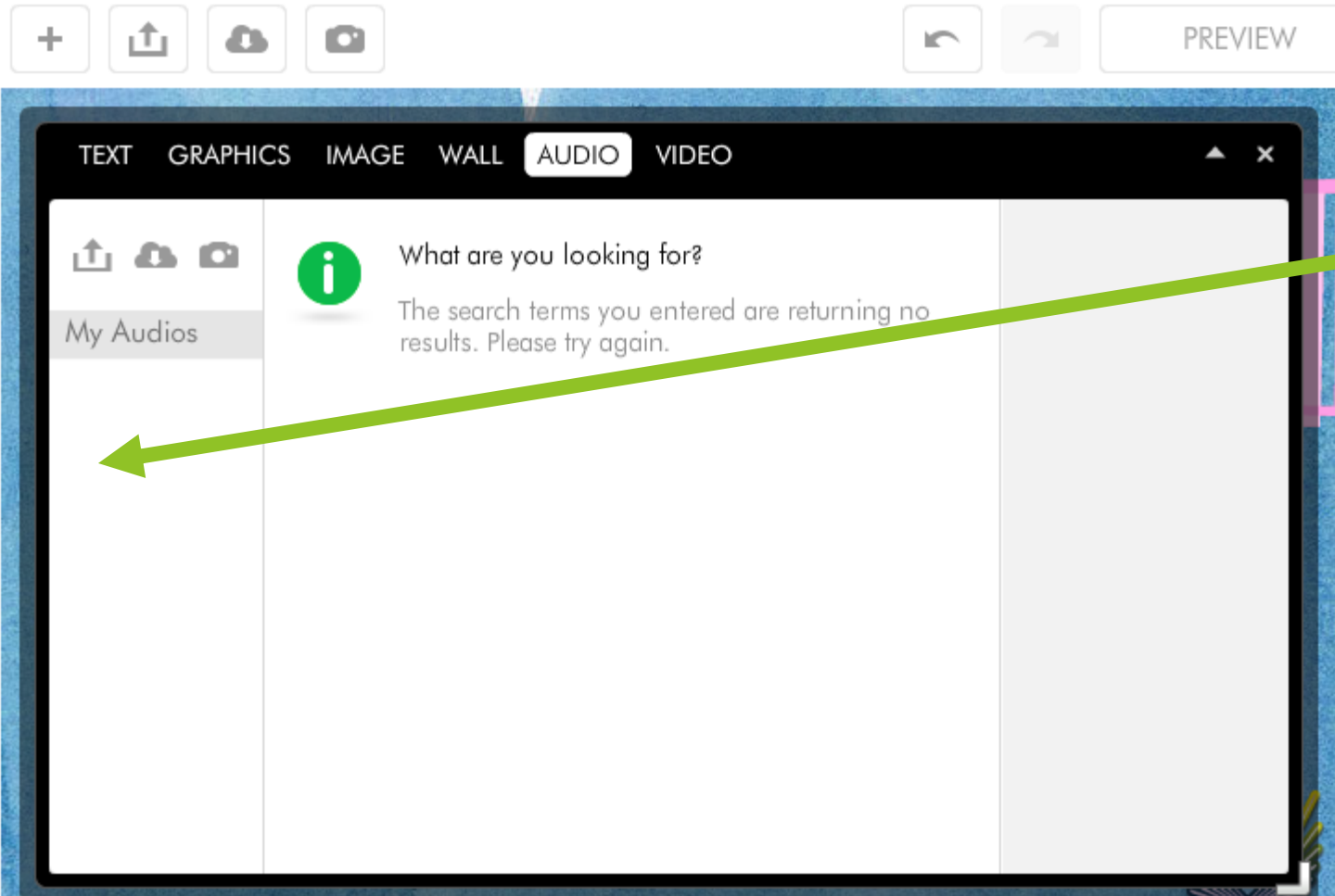
1. You can upload Images from your computer, Google, or a digital camera.

3. Pay attention to the way you fill your Wall. Adjust accordingly.

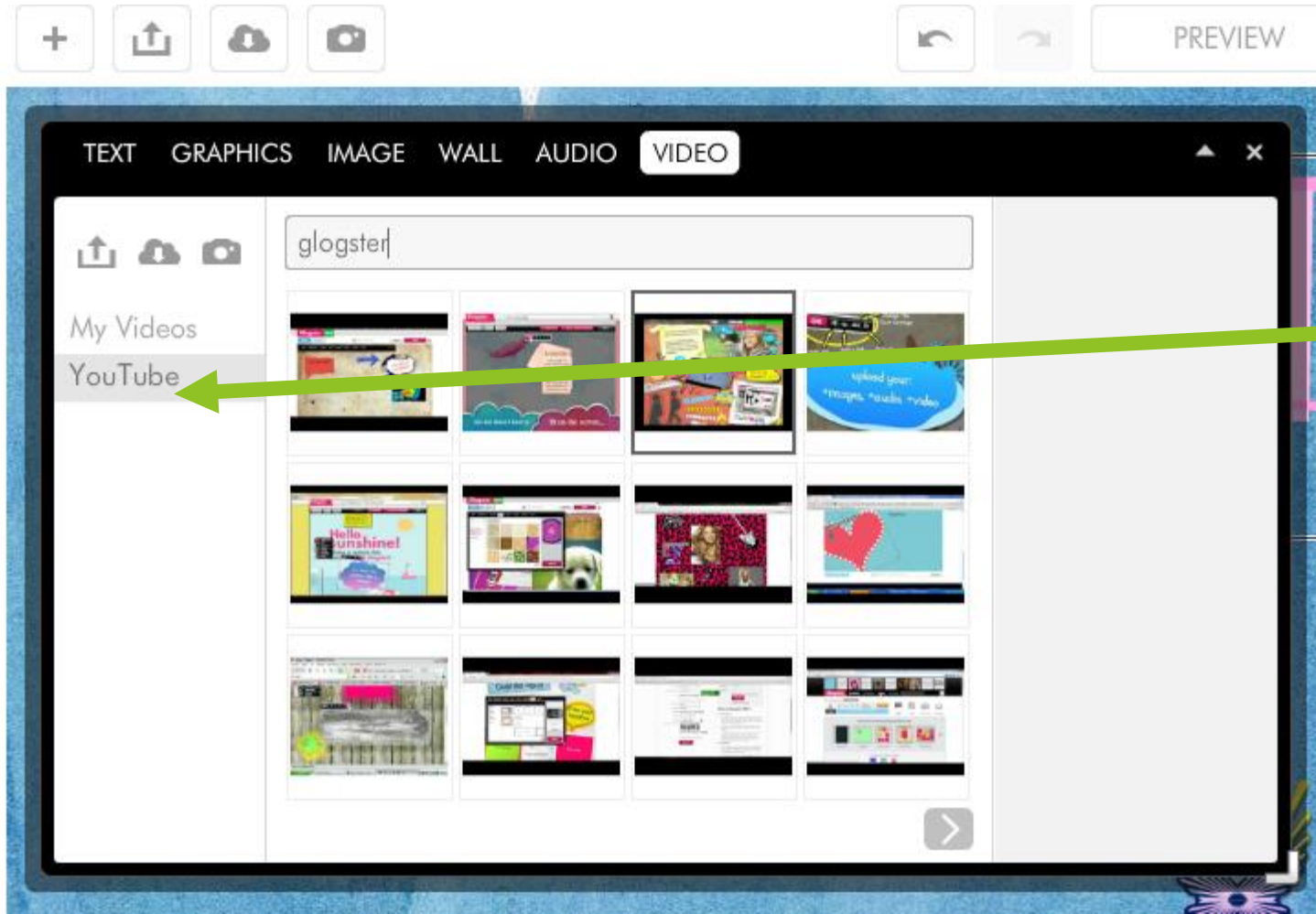
